Keeping Your Resume Up-To-Date

Even if you aren't planning on applying for a new job any time soon, it's a good idea to periodically update your resume whenever you gain new skills or qualifications. Not only will it help you save time when you're ready to apply for a new job, it can help you be prepared to pursue an unexpected opportunity like a promotion. Here are some tips on keeping it updated:

- 1. List your current contact info. Make sure your phone number, email, and location are all correct. If you have a professional online networking profile or portfolio, include that too!
- 2. Write a new summary. You experience level, skills, and experience are always changing; make sure this is reflected in the summary at the top of your resume.
- 3. Add resume keywords. Review job

Cream of Fiddleheads Soup Ingredients

- 1-1/2 cups fiddleheads, cleaned and finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 cubes chicken bouillon or 2 teaspoons chicken bouillon granules
- 1 small onion, minced
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 2 cups milk
- 2 cups heavy cream
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste

Instructions

- Steam the fiddleheads for 10 to 12 minutes or until tender. Set aside.
- 2. In a saucepan, melt the butter and bouillon cubes over medium heat. Add the fiddleheads, onions, and garlic, and cook for 10 minutes.
- 3. Add the milk, stir frequently, and heat thoroughly. Add the cream, stir to incorporate, and season with salt and pepper. Serve steaming hot.

- 4. Highlight relevant work experience. Make sure you're adding the new skills you've gained! And as you gain experience, some responsibilities in older jobs may be less relevant to new positions you seek and it is ok to remove those from your resume.
- 5. Include your most recent education. Whether college coursework, on-the-job certifications, or otherwise, make sure this is updated! It shows employers your commitment to advancing your skillset and knowledge.
- 6. Review the formatting and content. Make sure the formatting on your resume looks neat and clean. And be sure to proofread your resume too; spellcheck is great but won't catch everything. Don't be afraid to ask friends or colleagues to review it for you too.
